

Many of us would give up sodas or coffee during Lent. This worked out very well because Lent usually ended just in time to study for finals. Those late hours needed a lot of caffeine to stay awake and after having fasted from caffeine for 40 days we didn't have any problem with those late nights. At that point, a little caffeine went a long way. However as I reflect on that time, I am not at all sure how fasting from caffeine during Lent drew any of us closer to God. 
then you will have accomplished the true meaning of Lent. You will have prepared yourself for the coming of the Lord on Easter Sunday.


