



Continued from Pastor's Message

The Law of Moses is extremely important because it helps us to better understand what is right and what is wrong. It is hard to know how to do right until we can see how we have done wrong. The Gospel helps us to understand that while we cannot do right by our own power, our God loves us so much that God sent God's only Son, Jesus Christ to die for us on a cross while we were still sinners. We were doing wrong; breaking our relationship with God, and we did not even know it. And while we didn't know it God sent Jesus to die for us anyway so we would have the power and freedom in God's grace not to sin any more. The Law is not above the Gospel, and yet the Gospel is the fulfillment of the Law. Through the power of God's sanctifying grace we are able to turn away from violating the Law of Moses by growing in our love and imitation of the God we love until we are no longer weighed down by the temptation to sin. Entire sanctification is not something that only happens in death. Entire sanctification is possible right here and right now. The question for us is will we lean into God's grace to take strength in the name of Jesus that we might become more like Him? In the Name of Jesus Christ, Amen By God's Good Grace, Rev. 
