Central UMC participated in making a donation of \$535 from the Back Pack Program account towards this year's revitalized Back Pack Program which will assist up to 30 plus children.






Central UMM will meet on September 8th and October 13th for their monthly UMM Breakfast and fellowship meetings. All men of the church are invited for this fellowship gathering.


