

Have you ever felt like a nobody? Have you ever felt like the least likely person in the room to be asked to do something great or important? Have you ever been told you are too young? Have you ever been told you are too old? Have you ever been told you are just a Nobody, and you ought to sit down and be quite? I have, and I

have come to take it as a compliment. The reason I can take it as a compliment is because when we read Scripture it is exactly the nobodies God used to do great and wonderful things. David was the least of his children (1 Samuel father's 16:1-13). Jeremiah was to young to be a prophet (Jeremiah 1:4-10). 




