

read, but it sure steps on my toes. The basic point of the book is we have a lot of distractions in our lives. The devil knows he cannot sway us with a straightforward attack on our faith because we would see through that. If the devil said believe in me and follow me instead of God, we would only laugh in Satan's face for the whole truth of Scripture tells us in the end God wins. So, the devil tries to get our minds off of God and the life saving work of Jesus Christ on the cross. Instead, the devil gets us to focus on who to blame for this Covid-19 mess, or how we hate wearing masks.
