Word from the Pastor

Louis Armstrong once sang, "Dream a little dream for me." This is the start of a new year so let's dream a little bit together? Better yet, let's dream a lot together. Once upon a time I did a residency as a hospital chaplain. One of the most heartbreaking things I saw again and again was the family of people on life support when it was time to A WORD turn off the machines. What was heartbreaking was the split FROM THE PASTOR extremes of the people within the family. There were those who were so sad because they had lost a loved one. Then there were those who were so angry because they were still holding on to hope their loved one was going to live. They were living in denial and unwilling to face their current reality, and because they could not face their current situation they could not deal with the grief and move on toward the future. Their ideas about what was going to happen to their loved one was more important than their future. It absolutely broke my heart every time. Congregations make this same mistake today. We chase after our former glory all the time. We want church the way it used to be. We want worship the way it used to be. We want Sunday school to be the way it used to be. If Covid-19 has taught us anything, "Nothing is the way it used to be." I am not saying church is dead. I am saying even before Covid what a church looks like was changing. Covid sped that up and it has made the church dangerous. Every pastor knows each congregation has sacred cows they are unwilling to kill. Those sacred cows can be anything from the color of the carpet, someone's favorite pew, to a specific song sung during Advent. Don't touch those things because if you do then it won't be church, it won't be Christmas, I won't be fed as a Christian. Then the people of the church behave in some pretty unsavory ways because they are willing to sacrifice their sacred cow. Thanks to Covid-19 for many of us it feels like our herd of cows is dead. I think it is important for our future to face our reality. Things may not go back the way they were. That does not mean our church cannot still be great. If things do not go back exactly as they were, that does not mean our church is not great today. I invite you to dream with me. Dream about Central's future. Won't you dream a little dream for me?
